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The Utah Cancer Control Program (UCCP), in partnership with other agencies and organizations, offers free breast, cervical cancer, and cardiovascular screening to women ages 50-64.

The free screening services offered include: blood pressure, cholesterol, glucose screening, individual and group lifestyle coaching, mammogram, clinical breast exam (CBE), Pap test, annual reminder, diagnostic services for abnormal results, and treatment referral for breast or cervical cancer and pre-cancerous conditions.

The following income guidelines have recently been expanded to provide more women with these free screening services.
